SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The Texas College LEGACY Scholarship was established to recognize students who excel academically, exude leadership qualities, and are community service oriented. The scholarship recipient is expected to uphold the core values of the institution and maintain high academic scholarship. Scholarships are awarded based on need up to \$1,000 for the academic year (with no money to pocket). Students who receive the scholarship are considered LEGACY scholars and are recognized at the “black-tie” LEGACY Scholarship Fundraiser in March.

The criterion for consideration to become a LEGACY Scholar is listed below. The candidate must:

1. Be a full-time student enrolled at Texas College;
2. Complete a minimum of 15 credit hours for two semesters of course work at the end of the freshman year or higher;
3. Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale, for minimally one academic year;
4. Be able to articulate his/her vision for the future;
5. Be able to share his/her work toward community service;
6. Be able to articulate leadership ability;
7. Complete the application for consideration; and
8. Provide a letter stating reason for wanting to become a LEGACY Scholar.

Students may be recommended by faculty, staff and administration to apply for the scholarship. The deadline for submission of application is **Friday January 31, 2020**; applications received after this date **will not** be considered. Applications should be submitted to:
