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ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

A freshman applicant for admission to Texas College must have graduated from an accredited high school with a minimum of twenty-two credits or have successfully completed the General Education Development (GED) Testing Program. The distribution of credits should be as follows:

<i>Social Sciences</i>	<i>3 credits</i>

<i>Physical Education</i>	<i>1 credits</i>
<i>Speech</i>	<i>.5 credit</i>
<i>Fine Arts</i>	<i>1 credit</i>

Applicants seeking admittance into Texas College must submit the following:

- * An APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION
- * \$20.00 APPLICATION FEE. This fee is non-refundable and must be in the form of cash or a money order. Personal checks are not accepted.
- * An official HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT with signature and seal (if applicable) mailed directly from the high school to the College or where applicable, the GENERAL EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT (GED) Testing Program score report.

For Transfer Students – include the following items in addition to items stated above:

- * Official ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT(S) from all colleges/universities attended mailed directly from the college/university to the Texas College Office of Enrollment Services.
- * Official FINANCIAL AID TRANSCRIPT(S) from all colleges/universities attended mailed directly from the college/university to the Texas College Office Financial Aid.
- * A Texas College Transfer Student Reference Sheet.

The following items are necessary to complete the admissions files:

- * A \$300 Room Fee and a Room Reservation Form;
- * A \$150 Registration Fee
- * A medical examination report and proof of insurance coverage for all applicants;
- * Copy of the social security card;
- * A completed financial aid application.
- * If applicable, official scores on the SCHOLASTIC ASSESSMENT TEST (SAT) or the AMERICAN COLLEGE TESTING (ACT) Assessment Test for diagnostic purposes only.
