All **new student campus residents** are to report to the *Gus F. Taylor Gymnasium* for check-in and housing assignments on Friday, January 13, 2023, at 10:00 a.m.(CST). Make sure you've paid your housing fee, as well as, **that your financial aid has been completed.**

As the College seeks to maintain a safe and healthy environment for all, wearing a mask on campus and COVID-19 testing weekly is required for all students, faculty and staff. Additionally, all students seeking to move into on campus housing must submit proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 24 hours prior to arriving at the College. Any student without proof of a negative test will be tested upon entering the campus and prior to being permitted to register or move into the housing facilities. **If arriving after business hours, students must have proof of a negative test taken within 24 hours.**
