All students arriving without verification that the housing fee has been paid will be required to submit a Money Order for the \$300.00 prior to being assigned a room.

All **new student campus residents** are to report to the *Gus F. Taylor Gymnasium* for check-in and housing assignments on Friday, January 13, 2023, at 10:00 a.m.(CST). Make sure you've paid your housing fee, as well as, **that your financial aid has been completed**.

As the College seeks to maintain a safe and healthy environment for all, wearing a mask on campus and COVID-19 testing weekly is required for all students, faculty and staff. Additionally, all students seeking to move into on campus housing must submit proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 24 hours prior to arriving at the College. Any student without proof of a negative test will be tested upon entering the campus and prior to being permitted to register or move into the housing facilities. If arriving after business hours, students must have proof of a negative test taken within 24 hours.
