

2015-2016 VERIFICATION PROCEDURES

Thank you for choosing Texas College (TC). The Office of Financial Aid assists students in obtaining monetary assistance to pursue their education. Your 2015-2016 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called “verification”. Texas College performs “verification” on all applications selected by the Department of Education, and has the authorization to verify any application information that is believed to be incorrect. Please make certain you have all of the required documentation before submitting the packet to our office. Failure to submit all required verification documents by the posted financial aid deadline will result in no financial aid being awarded.

A Financial Aid Counselor will review the information on the documents submitted. All information will remain confidential. If there are any discrepancies between the information submitted on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and your submitted documents, corrections will be made on your behalf. You will receive a new Student Aid Report (SAR) indicating the changes made and the results. After the verification process has been completed you will receive your award package, within 5-7 business days.

Important Information: NO financial aid awards will be awarded until verification is complete.
